



Artem Cherkasov is a Professor of Medicine at the University of British Columbia (Vancouver, Canada) and a Director of Therapeutics Development at Vancouver Prostate Centre. Research interests include Computer-Aided Drug Discovery (CADD), Artificial Intelligence, Cheminformatics, and development of precision cancer therapies.

Dr. Cherkasov co-authored more than 200 research papers, 80 patent filings and several book chapters. During his tenure at the UBC, Dr. Cherkasov has been a principal applicant or co-applicant on a number of successful grants totalling over 80M dollars, and licenced 8 drug candidates to big pharma companies, major international venture funds and spinoff companies. In 2021 Dr. Cherkasov received UBC Faculty of Medicine Distinguished Achievement Award for Excellence in Fundamental Science, and received Tier 1 Canada Research Chair in Precision Cancer Drug Discovery.
