



Dr. Vladimir A. Palyulin since 1974 occupied research positions at Lomonosov Moscow State University and now he is a Head of the Laboratory of Medicinal Chemistry at the Department of Chemistry. His research interests currently include molecular modeling and molecular dynamics simulations, development of new approaches for QSAR studies as well as the design and synthesis of new allosteric modulators of ionotropic glutamate receptors potentially applicable as neuroprotective agents; some of them have demonstrated picomolar activity and successfully passed preclinical studies. He published more than 300 papers in the fields of medicinal chemistry, conformational analysis and molecular modeling, mathematical chemistry and QSAR. In 2008 he was elected as a member of the International Academy of Mathematical Chemistry.
