

Armen Sargsyan is a senior scientific researcher in the Scientific and Production Center "Armbiotechnology" National Academy of Sciences of Republic of Armenia. He entered in 2005 and graduated in 2009 Armenian State Agrarian University. Next two years he was master student in the same university. After graduation he continue his education in the International Scientific-Educational Center of NAS RA as a PhD student in the field of biotechnology (2011-2014). In 2015, after defence of thesis, he got PhD degree in biology. Scientific activity of Armen started in October 2006 when as volunteer he was involved in the works of Institute of Biochemistry NAS RA. Later, in the July of 2007 he was officially hired as junior researcher (quit in 2010). Since 2015 he is working in the SPC "Armbiotechnology" NAS RA, first in the laboratory of metabolism engineering and then in the laboratory of ecological safety. Now he is also a member of the Group of Enzymology which is new formed division. He is member of Scientific Council (structure providing management organization) SPC "Armbiotechnology" NAS RA, head of Young Scientists Union of the Center and from September 2022 vice head of same organization of whole National Academy of Sciences. Armen is author of 29 articles and more than 40 abstracts. He have participated in different stuff exchange programs and refresher courses (Newcastle University UK, Skaggs School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences USA, University of Barcelona etc.).
